The undersigned hereby applies for permission to construct a side sewer as indicated on the reverse of this sheet.

The undersigned hereby agrees to construct a side sewer as above applied for subject to all the following stipulation

1. That all regulations and requirements set forth by Resolution No.94, as amended of the Ronald Wastewater District, be complied fully and completely. Resolution No. 94 is by this reference, included in its entirety as a part of this side sewer application and the issuance of this permit and acceptance of the Owner or his agent will be construed as prima facie evidence of the Owner, or his agent have read same and agree to its terms and stipulations in their entirety.
2. The Owner hereby agrees to maintain the side sewer constructed under this permit in accordance with the rules and regulations on the Ronald Wastewater District and further will permit access with entry by authorized representatives of the Ronald Wastewater District on the property described in this permit at any reasonable time for the purpose of inspection for compliance with all the Ronald Wastewater District regulations.
3. The Owner is hereby notified that the Ronald Wastewater District sewerage system is of the sanitary type system and he agrees that he will not at any time connect storm water drainage from any source to the District's system; this includes, but is not limited to the following:
 - (a) Roof Downspouts.
 - (b) Building Footing Drains.
 - (c) Springs on the Property.
 - (d) Any Outside Ground-Water Drains.
4. The Owner and his Contractor hereby agree to accept full responsibility, and to hold Ronald Wastewater District harmless, for any liability, damage and/or costs which may accrue from prosecution of side-sewer work under this permit.
5. Contractor agrees to comply with Ronald Wastewater District Resolution 05-06 as amended, and in particular the Contractor agrees to provide a current Certificate of Liability Insurance that lists Ronald Wastewater District as an additional insured and includes an Additional Insured Endorsement that amends the Contractor's general liability insurance policy. If the work performed under this Side Sewer Permit extends into the Contractor's next policy year, Contractor shall promptly furnish a new Certificate of Liability Insurance, including necessary endorsement evidencing Ronald Wastewater District's status as an additional insured on contractor's policy.
6. The Owner and/or his Contractor hereby agree to safeguard the work done under this permit in such a manner as to prevent injury and/or damage to the public. Such precautions shall include the employment of all necessary ditch safeguards such as lanterns, barricades and safe access or egress through the working area.
7. The Owner and/or his Agent agree to employ a side-sewer contractor approved by the District and covered with adequate and satisfactory liability insurance, licensed by Ronald Wastewater District, for all work to be prosecuted on public roads and R/W's
8. The Owner and his Contractor agree to install the side-sewer covered by this permit in full compliance with the Sketch entitled "Side-Sewer Requirements which includes but is not limited to the following:
 - (a) Cover on Sewer Pipe at Property Line to be at least 36" below road grade.
 - (b) Cover on Sewer Pipe on private property to be at least 18".
 - (c) Minimum grade to be 2%.
 - (d) No bends to be sharper than a 1/8 bend will be permitted without a cleanout.
9. No backfilling will be allowed until the work has been inspected and approved by the District's authorized inspector. All backfill shall be tamped and/or water settled.
10. The Owner and his Contractor agree that all street cleanup and road restoration will be made to the satisfaction of the governing authority, i.e., City, County, or State Highway, etc.
11. The Owner and Contractor agree to obtain, at no cost or liability to the District, all other necessary permits or construction work to be accomplished under this permit.
12. The Owner and/or Contractor must call for inspection upon completion of any portion of side-sewer.
